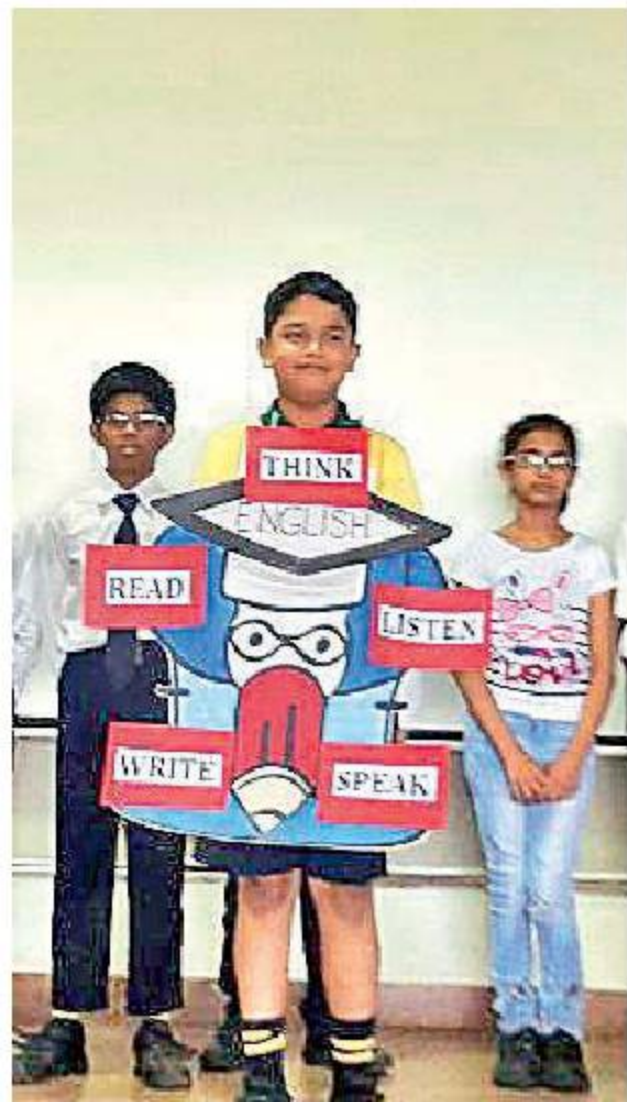


Special assembly on 'Friends Forever'
