TSVS students go on an industrial visit



Bhopal: Grade 10 students of The Sanskaar Valley School boarding took a geography field trip to 'Prakrit' to explore sericulture. Prakrit is a government centre for silk manufacturing.

The first stop was to learn about silkworm rearing, where the silkworms are cultured. The students came to know about different types of feeds and worms that result in different varieties of silk like mulberry, muga, eri, and tussar. The kids then visited the site where the raw material is processed and converted to fine silk yarn.
