Bhopal: Sanskaar Vidya Niketan is an initiative that began in 2015 and is promoted by The Sanskaar Valley School and the Dainik Bhaskar group. The aim is to run

an English-medium school that aims for the uplift of girls to help them lead better lives in future with education.

THE SANSKAAR VALLEY SCHOOL INITIATIVE

The first school had opened on The Sanskaar Valley School's campus, where 400 girls from Classes I-V now study. As part of the initiative, the girls are provided with books, notebooks, uniforms, shoes, bags, bottles, stationery and transport free of cost. The admission process is simple, keeping in mind the below-poverty-line families.

- One is located next to the Dainik Bhaskar office in MP Nagar
- The other is located in

- The centres will hold classes for students of Classes I-III & will admit 200 girls in each branch
- A total of 800 girls will
- be educated across the three centres
- Admissions to the MP Nagar branch have now begun
- The Kotwali branch will begin admissions in second week of July
